## NVFAC VOLUNTEER INSTRUCTOR AGREEMENT

This agreement entered into between the instructor named below and the Nevada Firearms Coalition (NVFAC) allows stated Instructor to promote, host, and present NRA Certified Courses and NVFAC approved courses, seminars, or programs as a volunteer Instructor of the Nevada Firearms Coalition.

- 1. Instructor must be currently NRA Certified for teaching the course that is being offered.
- 2. Instructors and Range Safety Officers (RSO) will be active members of NVFAC, approved by and part of the NVFAC Education & Training Division. Instructors and RSOs will be covered under the NVFAC business license and liability insurance when performing official duties for NVFAC.
- 3. Instructor may also teach NVFAC courses designated by NVFAC in advance.
- 4. Instructor must teach NRA and NVFAC courses in strict accordance with the course lesson plans.
- 5. Course fees will be determined by the following and must be approved by NVFAC Education and Training Division in advance of course offering.
  - a. Students must be member of NVFAC. See item 7 below
  - b. Instructor reimbursement to cover out of pocket expenses (mileage at \$.56 per mile, per diem at \$15.00 per meal, and lodging if necessary). Reimbursement will be documented by signed and dated receipts and mileage statement.
  - c. Costs of approved course materials.
  - d. A \$10.00 fee per student that will be paid to NVFAC.
  - e. Fees will be submitted to NVFAC within 10 days of course completion.
- 6. All students will be members of NVFAC. If they are not members when they register, they can register on line, or complete the application accompanied with a check made out to NVFAC at time of registration. This does not apply to programs that may be offered to the general public at large such as the NSSF First Shots program or others approved by NVFAC.

- 7. The NVFAC BE AWARE program, which includes the Be Aware handout, NSSF brochure "Firearms Responsibility in the Home" and Project ChildSafe locks (if available) will be incorporated as part of every course provided by NVFAC.
- 8. Instructor will provide proof of current NRA Instructor/Range Safety Officer credentials for any additional staff assisting with NRA courses. For NVFAC approved courses the Instructor and range staff must be approved by the Education and Training Division Committee. Approval will be based upon the course description, submitted lesson plan, additional credentials and or firearms resumes of the Instructors and support staff.
- 10. While presenting the course, the Instructor and support staff will identify themselves with approved NVFAC logo apparel.

I will support the goals and objectives of the NVFAC and will only provide positive comments about the organization and its members.
