

CONSERVATION & FIREARMS SAFETY SUMMER CAMP

CAMP RULES

These rules apply to the NVFAC Conservation & Firearms Safety Summer Camp being held in June 2018. It is important for parents, legal guardians and student attendees to be familiar with these rules and agree to follow them. Failure to follow these rules will result in the student being asked to leave the program and the Clark County Shooting Complex (CCSC) without a refund of fees.

- Registration must be completed before attending which includes the camp fee, signed liability waiver by both parent/legal guardian and student, and acknowledgement of camp rules and schedule

SAFETY

- All ammunition must remain at the range and stay on CCSC property
- For safety purposes, attendees will wear appropriate clothing (long pants, buttoned or pull over shirts, closed toed shoes-no flip flops or sandals, and required ear and eye safety devices
- Instructions provided by instructors and safety officers will be immediately obeyed
- All safety rules will be obeyed and followed
- Eating and drinking are restricted to breaks. No food is allowed on the ranges
- Students will wash their hands before eating and at the end of each day
- Students will wear ear and eye protection and team hats at all times as appropriate
- Students will stay with their team at all times
- A zero tolerance policy will be enforced regarding safety and following instructions
- No horse play in classrooms or on ranges

CONDUCT

- Attendees will be on time and at the proper location per the camp schedule
- Once attendees arrive on property, they will not leave the property until the end of the day, they may bring personal cars. Students being driven by parents or designated drivers must not leave with other persons without parental permission.
- No talking when instructors are talking
- No fighting
- No arguing, name calling, bullying, pushing, shoving or swearing
- Respect the property and dispose of all trash in appropriate containers
- Lunch, breaks and water will be provided. Attendees are encouraged to bring sun screen, personal snacks and water bottles.
- Skateboards, jewelry, video games, tablets and cell phones are not permitted
- Cell phones and other social media communication devices are not permitted and are not allowed on the classroom or on the ranges
- Attendees will be on time for all events
- Attendees are responsible for their personal belongings
- Attendees will tell the instructor when they are going to use the bathroom during class sessions
- Attendees will always be courteous and cooperative
- Foul language or verbal abuse will not be tolerated
- Horse play is not allowed
- Visitors are not permitted
- If daily medicines are required, arrangements must be made with the camp organizers in advance
- Apparel must not contain vulgar or inappropriate language or art work
- The summer camp and CCSC are not responsible for any lost or stolen items
